



Regulatory Impact Assessment

Preliminary analysis of the potential and collateral impacts of regulatory projects from the economic, social, environmental and public authority points of view.

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Challenges

- Risk of 5 autonomous tests!
→ Solution: a single test covering all these themes

Main objective

Awareness of the global impact of new decisions

Main weakness

"Auto-evaluation", absence of quality control, Usually poorly understood, poorly executed

- Anticipation
- Scope > exemptions
- Quality > verification by IAC
- Multi recipients: Gov, advisory bodies, Parliament, ...
- Transparency > publicity

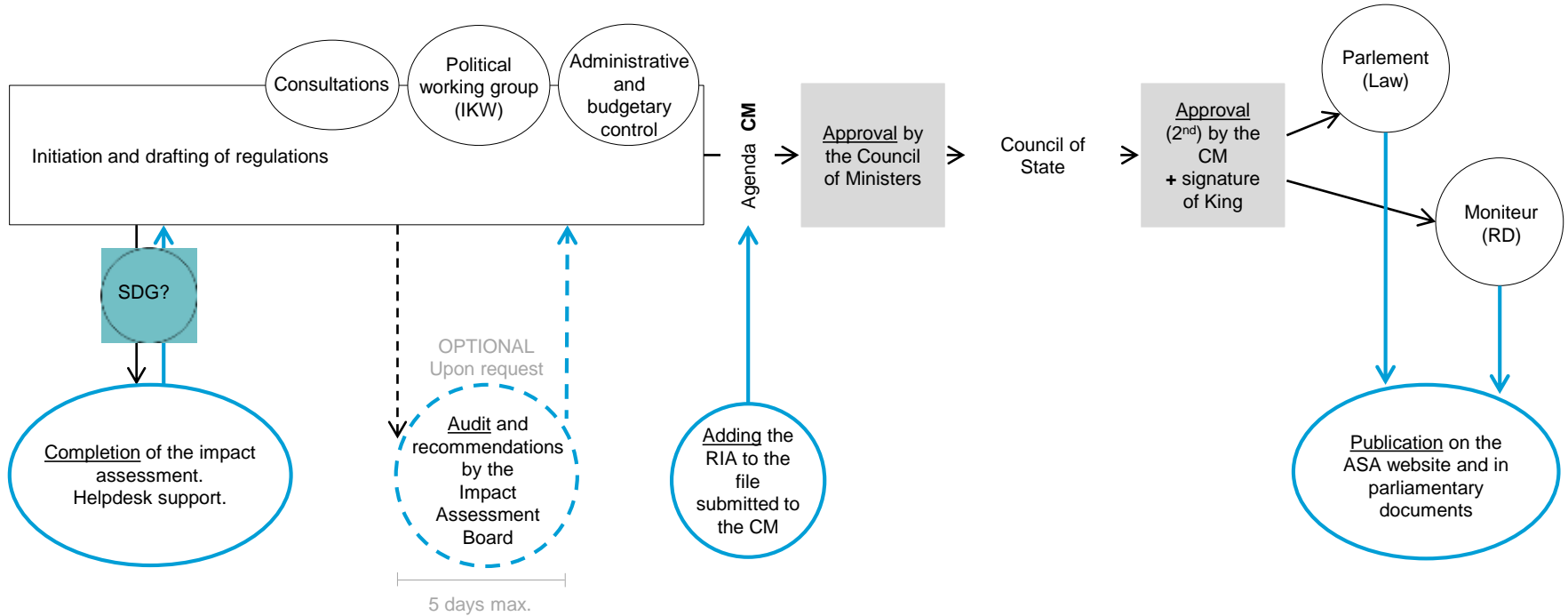
Benefits

- Extra step
- Obligation of transparency
- Responses to criticism
- Breaches in political arbitration

Exemptions

- Assent to International Treaties
- Approval of cooperation agreements between entities
- Formal decisions (codification, coordination, etc.) and budgetary techniques
- Self-regulation
- National Security and Public Order
- Urgency, to be justified (// Council of State)

To be mentioned in the recital and in the note to the CM.



Impact Assessment Committee

- Optional
- Response time: 5 working days
- Goal = improving RIA = improving regulation
 - completeness, accuracy and relevance
- → Recommendations, alternatives, ...
- Evaluation Report
- Secretariat > ASA

- Document of the Council of Ministers
 - confidentiality until the project is approved.
- RIA can be requested by:
 - an advisory body
 - a political working group ...
- Publication on the ASA website at an appropriate time

Challenges

Start without waiting time:

- 120 users of the electronic form
- Few appeals to the IAC
- Deadline of 5 days -> difficulty to coordinate
- +/- 60 RIAs published on the DAV website
- Alignment with a parliamentary document
- Preparation of a report at the end of the legislature
- Interest of certain social and economic partners
